**Sizes and Dots or wings?!**

**Sizes:** Choose between two sizes, a Short or a Medium and which one of the two diagrams to follow. The width in the 2 sizes are the same.

**Dots or Wings:** Also, make your choice between the two patterns "Wings" or "Dots" – both of them are described below.

The vest is worked by Domino-squares joined together as you go as shown on the diagram. When finished you work edges and sew the sideseams.

with BC and a wing or dot in a contrasting color according to the color scheme. Make your choice whether you want to do wings or dots before knitting (see the photo of the two models/patterns).

**How to Start**

Learn the different Domino techniques - for instance how to knit-cast-on - from the enclosed Domino Technique Folder, and knit a **Practice Piece**.

Look at the diagram to the right. When the Practice Piece is finished you must check your gauge before getting on. You will then know the principles and are ready to start knitting your vest.

Enjoy yourself - it is great fun to knit the Domino-squares!

**The Practice Piece**

**Panel 1 - 1<sup>st</sup> Square (A) - BC**

K-CO 29 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K to last st, p1.

**Row 2 (RS):** Sl 1 kwise (selvedge), k12, sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pss0, k12, p1 (selvedge).

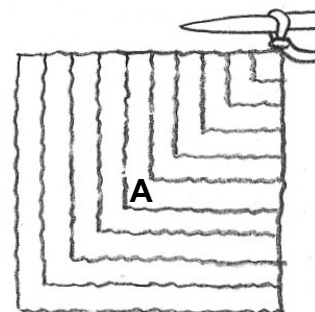
**Row 3:** Sl 1 kwise (selvedge), k to last st, p1 (selvedge).

**Row 4:** Sl 1 kwise, k11, sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pss0, k11, p1.

Rep Rows 3 and 4, dec 2 sts every RS row, until 3 sts rem, ending with a RS row.

**Next Row (WS):** Sl 1 kwise, k1, p1.

**Next Row:** Sl 1 kwise,



**Needles**

**Metric:** Domino-needles (dn) or 2 double-pointed needles 3 mm and a circular needle 3 mm.  
**3 mm = US size 2-3.**

**Gauge (Tension)**

Finish the Practice Piece before measuring/checking if the gauge is correct. Measure square C. Width and height should be to the same, namely 6 cm, and diagonally it should measure 8,5 cm. If your squares are smaller or larger than indicated above, you must knit another practice piece using thicker or thinner needles, accordingly, until the measurements - and thus the gauge - is correct. When your practice piece is correct, you have actually knitted the first part of your ZigZag Vest, namely panel 1, 2 and 3 on the diagram.

**Choose between "Wings" or "Dots"!**

Some of the squares in the diagram are marked I, II or III (Roman numerals). These squares are worked
