Square 1

Only for private use

SQUARE 1

Yarn: Use whatever you want or the yarn mentioned in the instruction.

Needles: Domino-needles (or short double pointed needles) which fits yarn.

Technique: Square 1.

Number of stitches: 25. The number of stitches can be any on even number of stitches.

Square 1

garter stitch, one color

Color: Curry

This square is a very simple garter st square.

Use short needles and K-darn 25 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K to the last st, p1. Mark the center 3 sts and move the mark upwards as you go.

Row 2 (RS): The yarnend is in the right side, and it can possibly be darned while knitting.

Sl 1 kwise, k to marked 3 sts (= k10), sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pssso, k to last st (= k10), p1 (= 23 sts).

Row 3 and all rows on WS: Sl kwise, k to last st, p1.

Row 4: Sl 1 kwise, k to marked center 3 sts (= k9), sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pssso, k to last st (= k9), p1 (= 21 sts).

Row 6: Sl 1 kwise, k to marked center 3 sts (= k8), sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pssso, k to last st (= k8), p1 (= 19 sts).

Cont this way with still less sts on the needles untill 3 sts rem.

Next row (WS): Sl 1 kwise, k1, p1.

Next row: Sl 1 kwise, k2tog, pssso (= 1 st, the end-st).

Break the yarn, pull it through the end-st, but leave it loose - or use the end-st as the first st of the next square.
