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## *Domino Chain Selvedge*

### *Why chain selvedge stitches?*

- *Because they are easy to pick up and knit in.*
  - *Because they are neat to look at also on the wrong side of the work.*
- These Chain Selvedges are simply a **MUST** in Domino-knitting.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: K to last st, p1.

2<sup>nd</sup> Row and all rows following: Sl first st kwise, purl last st.

This chained selvedge makes an excellent foundation for picking up sts. Therefore working the edge stitches this way is a "must" in DOMINO-knitting. When you "pick up and knit", it is done through both loops.
