<b>2-of-1 st</b>	make 2 sts out of 1 st by knitting into the front and back of the same st	<b>NR</b>	next row
<b>BC</b>	basic color(s)	<b>oz</b>	ounce(s)
<b>beg</b>	begin(ning)	<b>pick-knit</b>	pick up and knit
<b>beg st</b>	beginning stitch = the stitch used for starting the knit cast on	<b>Pick-purl</b>	Pick up and purl
<b>BO</b>	bind off (British: cast off)	<b>p</b>	purl
<b>C3sts</b>	Center 3 sts = slip 2 sts from the left ndl to the right hand ndl at the same time, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over the knitted st.	<b>p1f&amp;b</b>	purl into front and back of the same stitch (inc 1 st)
<b>CC</b>	contrasting color(s)	<b>p2tog</b>	purl 2 sts together
<b>circn</b>	circular needle(s)	<b>p3tog</b>	purl 3 sts together

<b>dpn</b>	double-pointed needles (British double-ended needles)	<b>rib</b>	rib, ribbing
<b>D-selv</b>	Domino-selvedge	<b>ridge</b>	k on WS, or p on RS, shows a ridge on RS. A garter st. ridge: knit 2 rows (1 <sup>st</sup> row on RS)
<b>dwk</b>	darning while knitting	<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>end st</b>	end stitch	<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>fig</b>	figure	<b>skp</b>	see: sl 1, k1, psso

<b>garter st(s)</b>	knit on RS, knit on WS	<b>SM(s)</b>	safety marker(s)
<b>inc</b>	increase(s); increasing	<b>sq or ◇</b>	square(s)
<b>k</b>	knit	<b>sl 1 pwise</b>	slip one as if to purl
<b>k1f&amp;b</b>	knit into front and back of same stitch (inc 1 st)	<b>sl 1, k1, psso</b>	slip one, knit one, pass slipped st over
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 together	<b>ssk</b>	slip 1 st kwise, k2tog, pass the slipped st over the 2tog st.
<b>K-CO</b>	knit cast-on	<b>st st</b>	stockinette / stocking stitches / knit on RS, purl on WS
<b>kwise</b>	knitwise, as if to knit	<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>M1</b>	make 1 st, insert needle from behind under the running thread (between st just worked and the next), place it twisted on left-hand needle and knit it.	<b>tbl or k-tbl</b>	through back loop
<b>MC</b>	main color	<b>tog</b>	together
<b>mm</b>	millimeter(s)	<b>tw-selv</b>	twisted selvedge
<b>mrk(s)</b>	marker(s)	<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>ndl</b>	needle(s)	<b>wyb</b>	with yarn in back

		<b>wyt</b>	weaving yarn tails while knitting
